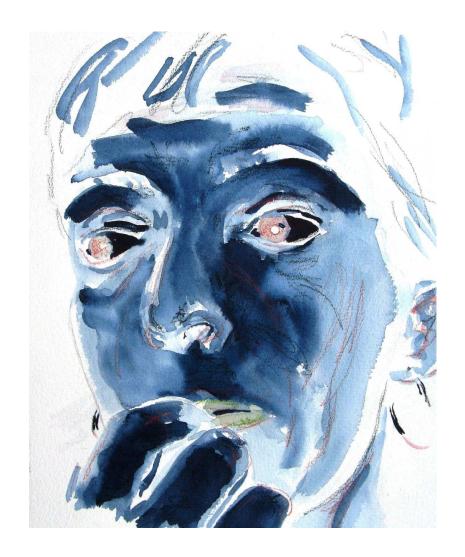


Bad Side of the Moon
